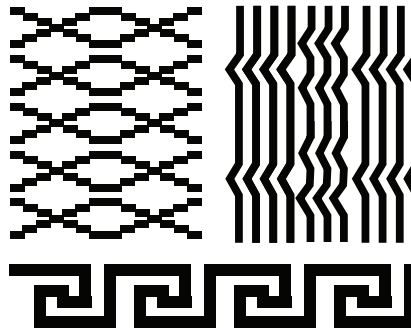
Why is there a goat on a teapot?

a FINIAL is a decorative ornament on top of something. On a teapot, it also serves as a handle to open the lid when the pot is hot.

Finials are often wood to help stay cool. Some are simple (spheres, discs, urns), some are fanciful (acorns, squash, berries, swans, even cows). How many finials can you find nearby?

What patterns would you put on a teapot?

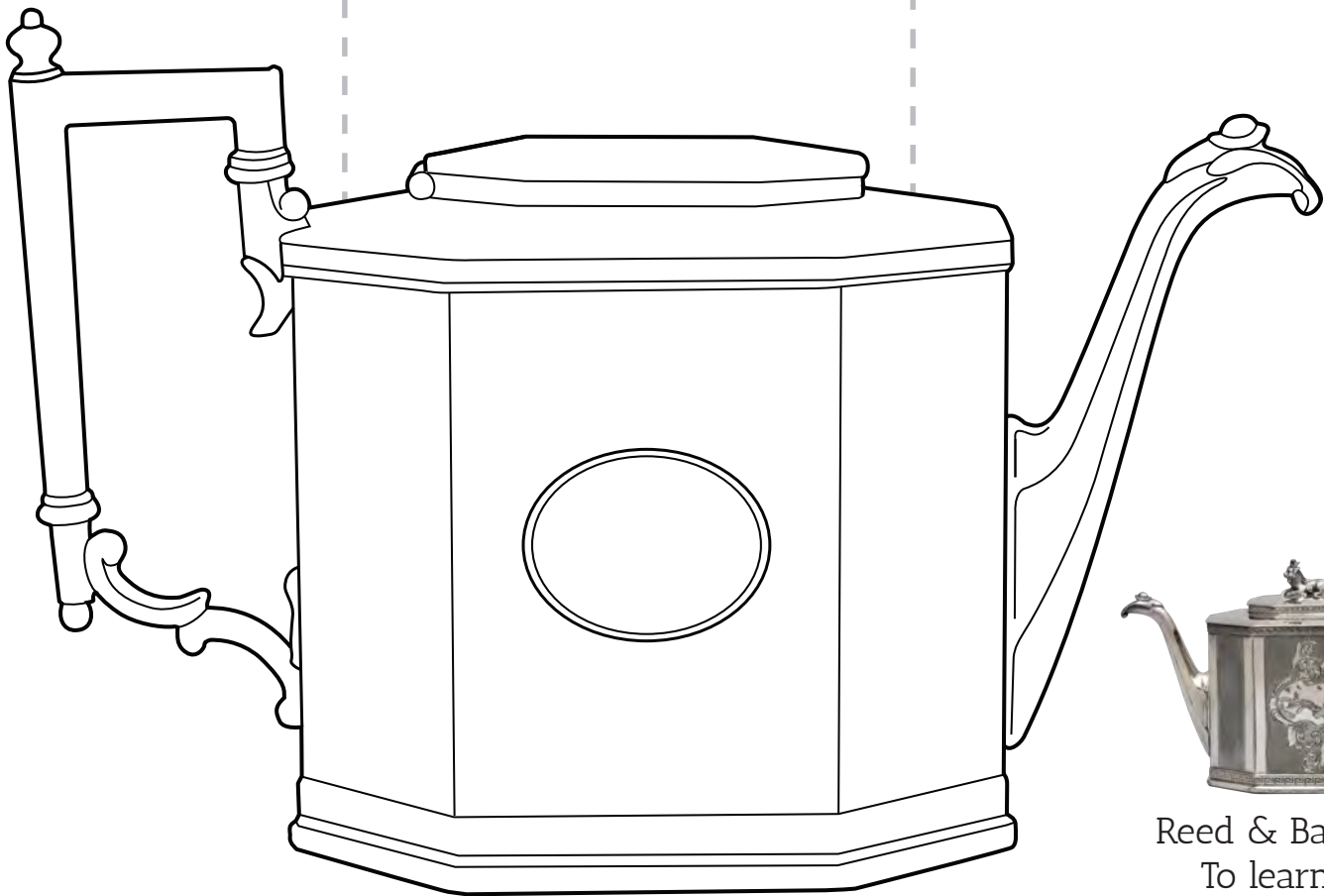
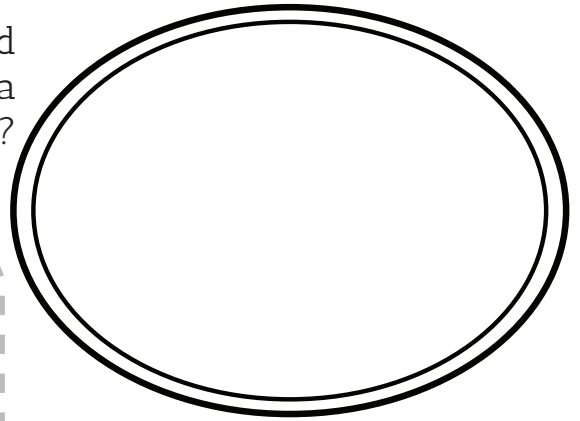
What finial would you put on top of a teapot?
